
The multitude of possibilities to attend the AMIE & SuSIE and the related multitude of access possibilities via **GoToWebina**r may confuse you. Therefore:

Attendees who plan to actively contribute to the session (with own presentation).


Upon request (chat or question) you can be advanced by the (co-) organizers to panelists during the session (maximum 25 panelists at a time).



Presenter


The person who is given by the (co-)organizer the *momentary* right to share his/her screen and to talk

Passive attendees






Sponsored Workshops are organized like this

All attendees (participating via computer, tablet or smartphone) are passive and can ask written questions only.
















If you use GoToWebinar for the first time, you have to run "Try a test session" and then download the program called "GoTo Opener" to your computer.

Downloading the GoToWebinar instant Join App





If asked: select "computer audio" (**not** "telephone call")

Now

- the installation should be completed,
- you can go back to the email with the link to the session,
- press the link
- and you should be in the virtual conference room.

As soon as the organizer has entered the conference room, the session can start.


The organizer can make you a presenter, you can present your data for example by sharing your screen (showing a powerpoint presentation) and speak, and if you activate your camera, you will be seen by the audience, too.

How to use the virtual conference room as a presenter

When you are made the presenter, you will find the following panel at your screen:






That's it for the moment!

Giving a presentation may not be new for you.

The only function you will need to get used to as a presenter is:



You can use any of these options during your presentation to highlight aspects, but be aware of two pitfalls:

- To proceed to the next slide, you have to activate "Normal non-drawing mode" again
- Before going to the next slide, you have to press "Erase all drawings"

Play a bit around and you will get used to it.



GoToWebinar Attendee System Check for Classic Webinars

Looks good! You can join a webinar.



Are you hosting a webinar? Check your system.

Even if the "Check system requirements" message looks like this, you may fail activating your camera and/or microphone, in particular (but not only) when using a Mac.


Therefore don't forget to press

"Try a test session".

When your installation fails







Sorry, this is in German. It says: you are going to participate with switched-off camera.

In this case, most likely your computer does not permit GoToWebinar to access your microphone and camera.

I was able to reproduce this problem on the Mac of my son.

Solution: allow GoToWebinar to get access to your camera and microphone

You should then proceed as follow:



Go to the privacy settings of our computer and allow GoToWebinar to get access/control over your computer/camera/microphone.



It may look like this or different ...

You may have to re-boot your computer!!



Without reboot it didn't work on my son's Mac, thereafter without any further problem.
